Puppetry which had significant royal support is said to have preceded human theatre in Myanmar. Puppets are carved from wood and finely clothed.



Figures are usually painted white with fine quality talc (soapstone) mixed with water, while details are added in color. The basic strings attached to the crossbar are at the temples, shoulders, and spine.



The intricate marionettes of Burmese. Popular belief traces string puppetry to Pagan in the 11th century.
