Was the acting convincing?

What about the movie set?

What do you think about the locations where some of the scenes were shot?

Does the movie use any visual effects? What do you think? Do they look real?

Are they better than the visual effects seen in other movies that you have watched?

To you, what is the most memorable scene in the movie?

What about the dialogues or language used in the movie? Are they appropriate for the general audiences?

Would you recommend the movie to others?

Who should watch the movie? Why?
